The aim of the Bioeconomy School is to offer to PhD students, young scholars and researchers from different disciplines an overview of the main scientific topics and of the related advanced competences that are necessary to understand and govern the **Bioeconomy transformation**.

The program offers a set of multi-disciplinary lectures, organized in sub-modules, ranging from the introduction to the basic scientific toolbox used in Biosciences and Economics, to the discussion of more specific case studies related to ongoing research and innovation projects (e.g. NODES, ProPla).

Mastering these aspects is expected to be relevant for entrepreneurs, public institutions and researchers working on these topics. Besides the classes, the instructors will provide mentoring sessions to the participants, with feedback on their research interests and ongoing works.
